



## minister's message



Every Sunday, I like to go to church a few hours before service starts. I check over the powerpoint, pray for God's presence to fill the building, visualize people's faces, run through the service a few times, and then I'll simply pace back and forth. Remember, I love pacing. It's what

I do. Often times, as I pace alone in the church, I will look out the windows and see one of our neighbors going for a jog down Miller Avenue. Others will take their dogs out for a morning walk. I can't be certain, but I imagine many of these people will not attend a Sunday service at any point in the day. It's a shame, but unfortunately, it's also a growing trend.

In 2015, I hope we can be a church that is really focused on the mission that Jesus personally gave to us: making disciples and spreading God's love. While the mission is a noble task, it might also be a bit frightening to think about what this mission focus might mean for us. Will Pastor Andy now ask us to cold call people into accepting Jesus as their lord and savior? Will we abandon our familiar worship service in favor of "seekerfriendly services" popularized by mega churches like Willow Creek?

When I observe my brother taking care of my niece, I can't help but smile. This is the same person I grew up with playing basketball, pulling pranks on my parents, and getting into fights over the TV remote. So, at times, I am in disbelief that he could become such a good parent. Although fatherhood is a totally new and different experience, my brother is still the same person he's always been. As the oldest of three, he always possessed a nurturing, responsible, and caring side. Fatherhood simply provided an occasion for him to display and put these skills to further use. In short, it's different, but it's also the same.



May this year be different, but also at its heart, be very much the same.


We'll enjoy a pizza dinner plus, of course, popcorn with our movie!
